HONORS LIBRARY OF MICHIGAN

In recognition of its outstanding contributions to the genealogical community, the Library of Michigan received the 1988 Director's Award from the Federation of Genealogical Societies, Davenport, Iowa.

Basis for the Library's selection was its conversion of all genealogical titles into an online catalog, extended public hours and its expansion into the new Michigan Library and Historical Center building at 717 West Allegan Street, Lansing.

The Library also has received the largest grant ever awarded by the Talbert and Leota Abrams Foundation of Lansing to purchase extensive genealogy and local history collections on microfiche and 1860 printed census indexes.

In addition, the Foundation has funded Library research for publications on "Michigan Cemeteries: A Comprehensive Guide" and "Michigan 1870 Census Index".

10. I will read at least one "How To" book this year, or make more frequent use of "How To" books available at the public library.
11. I will not allow myself to become discouraged or frustrated in my research. When unable to progress on one surname, I will research another.
12. As the family genealogist I will always keep two questions in mind: If not I, then who? If not today, then when?
